1 A MEMORIAL

2 PROCLAIMING JANUARY 25, 2008 TO BE "GALLUP-MCKINLEY DAY" AT  
3 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

5 WHEREAS, the city of Gallup and McKinley county are the  
6 northwestern gateway to New Mexico; and

7 WHEREAS, the city of Gallup and McKinley county reflect  
8 the rich cultural, recreational and economic diversity of New  
9 Mexico; and

10 WHEREAS, the city of Gallup is the home of the Gallup  
11 national historic district; and

12 WHEREAS, the city of Gallup is a center of commerce for  
13 the members of the Navajo Nation and has been a corridor for  
14 cross-country rail traffic since the nineteenth century; and

15 WHEREAS, McKinley county has the greatest number of  
16 Native American residents of any New Mexico county and is the  
17 home of many of the members of the Navajo Nation and the  
18 Pueblo of Zuni who reside in New Mexico; and

19 WHEREAS, McKinley county is the home of Red Rock state  
20 park and Red Rock museum and of one of the largest gatherings  
21 of Native Americans, the annual intertribal Indian ceremonial;  
22 and

23 WHEREAS, McKinley county incorporates the Continental  
24 Divide, which separates the watersheds of the Pacific and  
25 Atlantic oceans;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
2 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 25,  
3 2008 be designated as "Gallup-McKinley Day" at the New Mexico  
4 house of representatives to honor and showcase the many facets  
5 of the city of Gallup and McKinley county; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be  
7 transmitted to the mayor and city council of the city of  
8 Gallup and to the board of county commissioners of McKinley  
9 county.
