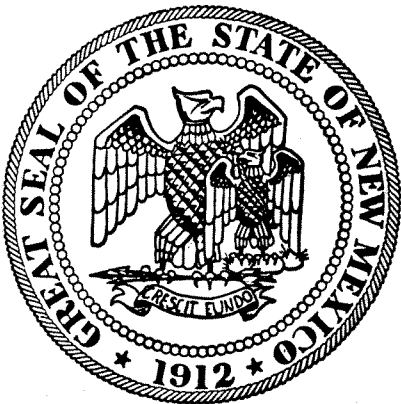

1 A MEMORIAL

2 REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO MUSIC COMMISSION TO USE A LESS
3 STRINGENT RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR ENTRANTS IN THE NEW MEXICO
4 COWBOY SONG COMPETITION.

6 WHEREAS, the New Mexico house of representatives in 2007
7 passed House Memorial 70 requesting the New Mexico music
8 commission to conduct a competition for a New Mexico cowboy
9 song; and

10 WHEREAS, the New Mexico music commission is conducting a
11 competition for a New Mexico cowboy song and is receiving
12 entries in the competition; and

13 WHEREAS, House Memorial 70 directed that the competition
14 be open to any person who was born in New Mexico or who has
15 lived in New Mexico consecutively for the past twenty years;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the New Mexico music commission reports that
18 entries have been received from persons with strong New Mexico
19 ties who do not meet the standard of twenty consecutive years'
20 residence in New Mexico and that this residency requirement
21 may unduly restrict entries in the competition;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
23 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico
24 music commission be requested to open the competition to any
25 person who was born in New Mexico or who has lived in New
