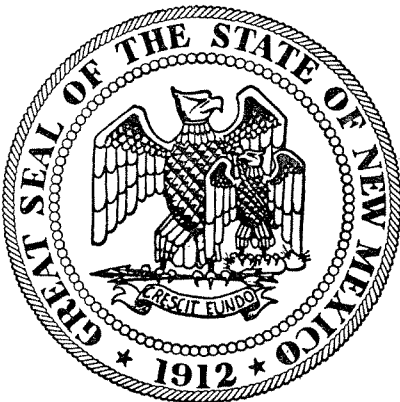

1 A MEMORIAL

2 REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO CREATE A PLANNING COMMITTEE TO
3 PROMOTE THE USE OF INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS IN
4 NEW MEXICO.

6 WHEREAS, "intelligent transportation systems" is the
7 term used by the federal department of transportation and the
8 transportation industry to describe the development and
9 deployment of advanced technology to improve the safety and
10 performance of surface transportation systems; and

11 WHEREAS, federal transportation legislation in recent
12 years required development of a national intelligent
13 transportation systems program plan, and the federal
14 department of transportation provides research funding and
15 other support to encourage the development of intelligent
16 transportation systems nationwide; and

17 WHEREAS, intelligent transportation systems increase the
18 efficiency and safety of transportation infrastructure; and

19 WHEREAS, the successful deployment of intelligent
20 transportation systems in New Mexico will benefit economic
21 development, public safety, technology transfer and
22 information exchange; and

23 WHEREAS, successful deployment of intelligent
24 transportation systems depends on the cooperation and
25 involvement of stakeholders in the public sector at the

1 federal, state and local levels, on the private sector and on
2 the research and development communities;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
4 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the governor be requested to create a
5 governor's planning committee on intelligent transportation
6 systems to evaluate the progress of intelligent transportation
7 systems development in New Mexico and make recommendations on
8 strategies to support the continued development and
9 maintenance of intelligent transportation systems in
10 New Mexico; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor be requested to
12 include as members of the planning committee on intelligent
13 transportation systems state officials and members of the
14 public who have expertise in the fields of transportation,
15 information technologies, public safety and economic
16 development; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
18 transmitted to the secretary of transportation, the secretary
19 of information technology, the secretary of economic
20 development and the governor. _____
