Honorable President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and return SENATE BILL 334, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-Second Legislature, First Session, 2015.

Senate Bill 334 would alter the statutory requirements of judges serving in the 12<sup>th</sup> Judicial District; and, among other issues, would result in significant problems in case management jeopardizing public safety in this district.

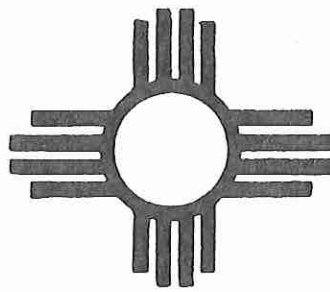


RELATING TO THE COURTS; AMENDING A SECTION OF CHAPTER 34

OFFICE IN LINCOLN COUNTY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:


SECTION 1. Section 34-6-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1971,  
Chapter 52, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

"34-6-15. JUDGES--TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.--There  
shall be four district judges in the twelfth judicial  
district. At least one of the district judges shall be  
designated to maintain the judge's principal office in Lincoln
